

Salona 34 – Cruiser racer in the race for the European boat of the year

Croatia has a serious candidate for the European boat of the year. The new ten-meter model of Salona has been nominated for a prestigious award as the perfect example of the access to the boat construction that has been successfully applied by AD boats on the entire range of Salona sailing boats.

Slim and attractive design of the new boat follows the style of rewarded Salona 37, but with mild lines, characteristic design of the bow as well as the whole range of details, the new Salona seems to be significantly bigger than her 34 feet length.

Cruiser racer from Solin seizes the attention with her attractive and fast gauge as well as with her uncompromised construction that enables her the ability of sailing under all conditions and a successful competition on the regattas scene.

Important design significance is an open Mediterranean style cockpit, but closed poop deck bench originally designed for the Baltic Sea is also available.

A special part of the manufacturing process is a sandwich construction with the internal stainless-steel reinforcement, which along with the interior reinforcement contribute to the firmness and durability of the boat.

Salona 34 offers the perfect combination of high quality, comfort and performances.

Reactions from the boat show in Amsterdam and Genoa imply on the existence of significant chances that Salona 34 will be pronounced European boat of the year. Her secret is that she was made on the tradition of the recognizable quality.
